ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED:

- In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee
- For duplicate entries
- If the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or show secretary

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

The A.K.C. will collect the above fees for each 1st Entry of a dog & each Additional Entry of the same dog in regular & non-regular recordable single entry classes in all A.K.C. Licensed & Member Club Events. Event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all fees for the A.K.C. & payment of all fees to the A.K.C. as stipulated in *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Ch 11, Sec 2*

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. **NO DOUBLE HANDLING** will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. **There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show.** Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed. All awards will be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award. The Show Secretary should be advised of any award discrepancies.

A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Chinese Shar-Pei, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc). At the discretion of the judge, the following breed may be judged on the table or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Cardigan Welsh Corgi. At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels & Whippets. The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Basset Hounds, Bulldogs and Chow Chows.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, Best in Show, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and Best in Show competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds. **IRISH WOLFHOUNDS ARE NOT A RAMP DESIGNATED BREED.**

THE SHOW GIVING CLUB, THE SHOW SECRETARY, THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, ETC. The Irish Wolfhound Club of America, Inc. will award at its National Specialty a Three (3) Point Major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch Entry is twice the required number for a Five (5) Point Major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOGS for Veteran Dogs 6 years of age or older

VETERAN BITCHES for Veteran Bitches 6 years of age or older

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** in the Veteran Dog Class(s) and spayed females **may be entered** in the Veteran Bitch Class(s) at independent specialties only.

NOTE: 1st Place winners of Veteran Dog / Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed **IF** undefeated in any other class at this show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS for Stud Dogs and two or more of their Get
Get need not be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee – this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the Standard of the Breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS same as for the Stud Dog
except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and produce for get.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and spayed females may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

BRACE CLASS Fee is \$31.00 as a unit
Effective 1/1/05 – Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers.

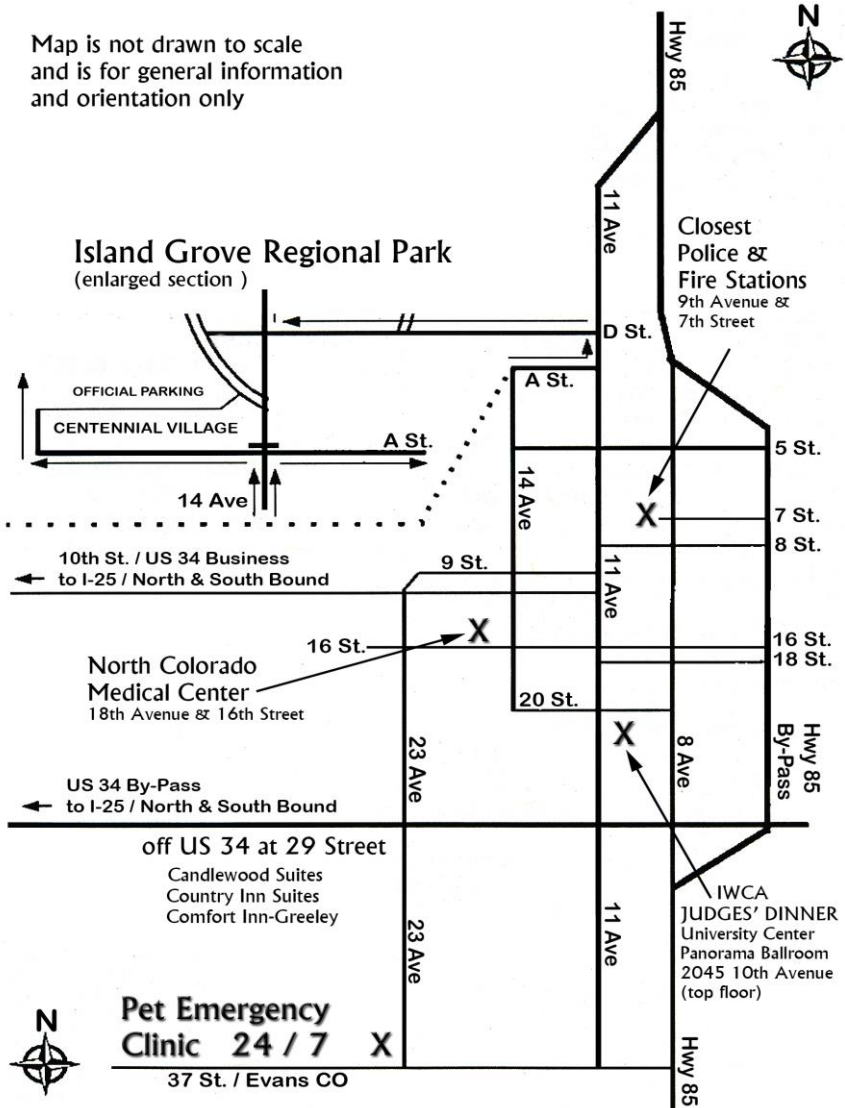
